NYSREEF's Mission, Goals and Management were reviewed. The wording, pertaining to management and regions was discussed. The committee recommends removing the reference to regions to better align with the changes made by NYSAR in 2020. This matter will be brought to NYSAR's CEO for review and then further action will be taken as needed.

At the end of 2020, the foundation had assets of \$229,029.61 with \$10,992.66 in net income.

The foundation approved the awarding of 61 scholarships in the amount \$16,255.

A summary of 2020 donations showed \$2,985 in individual donations, \$21,400 in local board donations, and \$15,000 in corporate donations.

A summary of local board scholarship donations vs the scholarship amounts they receive will be added to the agenda, moving forward. This information will be utilized to help with fundraising/donation purposes.

Directors were reminded to sign up at Smile.Amazon.com so a percentage of their purchases could be donated by Amazon to the Foundation.

Directors will be reaching out to local board presidents and EOs over the next few months soliciting contributions.

The foundation will be holding an auction each quarter during the year and will auction items off using the NYSREEF Facebook page.

The Foundation scholarship has been renamed as the **Priscilla Toth Education Scholarship** in honor of Priscilla Toth, who retired in 2020.
