President's Report

With no corrections, the minutes of the October 2, 2022 Executive Committee meeting held at the Turning Stone Resort & Casino in Verna, NY were approved as published.

Budget & Finance Committee

The Budget & Finance Committee recommends that NYSAR take \$100,000 from Reserves to replenish the Disaster Relief Fund.

The Budget & Finance Committee recommends that NYSAR take up to \$50,000 from Reserves to update the NYSAR trade show booth.

Issue Mobilization Committee Leah Caro, Legislative Steering Chair

The Issues Mobilization Committee recommends that NYSAR approve up to \$330,000 from the Issues Mobilization Fund in support of a public facing campaign in opposition to state legislation that would impose Good Cause Eviction in New York.

Organizational Planning Committee

The Organizational Planning Committee recommends that the NYSAR bylaws be amended to identify the Immediate Past President as an officer along with the President, President-Elect, and Treasurer as follows:

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS

D. IMMEDIATE PAST PRESIDENT: The Immediate Past President shall serve as an officer of the Association in the year immediately following the year served as President. The Immediate Past President shall serve as the Chairperson of the Nominating Committee. In addition to the other duties set forth in these bylaws or Association policy the President may assign duties to the Immediate Past President including but not limited to travel, attendance at Realtor functions and various other duties. If the Immediate Past President accepts those duties assigned by the President, NYSAR will reimburse the Immediate Past President for necessary travel and expenses pursuant to NYSAR's reimbursement policy. In the event of a vacancy, the position will not be filled.

SECTION 2. TERM OF OFFICERS:

- A. The elective year shall be January 1 to December 31.
- B. The President, President-Elect, Treasurer and Immediate Past President shall each serve a term of one year.
